"IS INSTALLING A SURVEILLANCE UNIT INSIDE OF RENTAL PROPERTIES LEGAL?"

Yes, it is legal to install security cameras to monitor your rental property, however, it is illegal to place them where tenants have a reasonable expectation of privacy.

Any cameras should be pointed towards common areas to ensure this rule is followed and tenants privacy is respected.

You also need to inform tenants or any parties involved in the rental agreement that video surveillance is present at the property, no matter the security solution you use to do this.

If you wish to utilize mobile surveillance units on the external parts of the property grounds, you can do so, but you need to ensure the cameras are made visible to the public and have clear signage to inform individuals that surveillance monitoring is present there.
