Holiday Parking Lot Security Checklist

- 1 Lighting & Visibility
- Ensure all parking lot lights are operational and provide bright coverage
- Replace burned-out bulbs immediately
- Check that entrances, exits, and pedestrian pathways are well-lit
- Trim shrubs, trees, or decorations that may block visibility
- 2 Access Control & Traffic Flow
- Clearly mark vehicle and pedestrian pathways
- Use barriers or cones to control traffic flow during busy shopping days
- Designate loading/unloading zones and keep them supervised
- Lock and restrict access to unused areas of the lot
- **3** Customer Safety Measures
- · Offer escorts for employees or shoppers leaving after dark
- Set up "safe zones" or call stations for visitors needing assistance
- Provide clear signage for emergency exits and assistance contact info
- Remind shoppers not to leave valuables visible inside vehicles

4 Emergency Preparedness

- Use WCCTV's voice-down feature for emergency communication.
- Ensure first aid kits and AEDs are accessible
- Review evacuation routes and post maps in visible locations

5 Seasonal Considerations
