

WALKING IN THE PARKING LOT

- Stay alert and walk briskly as criminals look for easy marks.
- Avoid distractions when walking so that you can see where you're going and who is in your vicinity.
- Know your surroundings.
- If you notice odd behavior, inform security or the police immediately.
- Walk with others when possible.
- Walk in a well-lit area.
- Be aware of noises and movements.
- Be ready to open your vehicle.

WHEN YOU GET TO YOUR VEHICLE

- Open a door at a time if there is a need too open more than one.
- If someone approaches your vehicle, do not open your door or roll down your window.
- Lock the doors when you are in your vehicle.
- Start the engine immediately when you get in your vehicle.

SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY

- Retreat to a well-populated area and call the police or security.
- Wait in a safe place until the police or security arrive to survey the area and let you know it is safe to go to your vehicle.
- If you are nervous about walking to the parking lot alone, ask security to escort you.
- If you notice someone in or around your vehicle, leave the area quickly and call the police or security.
- Describe as many details about the individual as you can to the authorities.
